FUNDAMENTALS OF DESIGN:

Choosing the appropriate lighting fixture for your Formal Dining Room



DETERMINING DIAMETER:

Add the length and width of the room (in ft) together. Convert the total feet into inches.

Ex: 10' x 12' = 22" Diameter

The chandelier should be 1/2-3/4 the width of the dining table below.

DETERMINING HEIGHT:

A chandelier should hang 30-34" above table for a 8' ceiling height.

Add 2-3" for each additional foot of ceiling height.
